

School Sports Funding

Primary Sport's Funding 2016/17

The Government is providing additional funding this academic year to our school to improve the provision of Physical Education (PE) and sport in primary schools across the country. This funding (provided jointly by the Departments for Education, Health and Culture and Media and Sport) is being allocated to primary school headteachers. The funding is ring-fenced and therefore can only be spent on provision of PE and sport in schools.

At Repton Primary we have developed an action plan to continue to provide sustained improvement in PE provision and raise achievement for all pupils in PE and sport.

Our funding is £9,089 for this year and our priorities mean that funding for 2016-17 will:

- Develop Continued Professional Development (CPD) for Teachers, HLTA's and TA's to improve expertise in PE teaching in focus areas eg: by the new Subject Leader working with South Derbyshire School Sport Partnership (SDSSP) and by staff observing 'Outstanding practice' and accessing planning from Premier Sports Coaches and SDSSP coaches.
Costing - SDSSP - £2150,00, Effective Sports Coaches -£6,630 (paid by Sports premium/supply cover budget).
- Continue to develop Forest school initiatives across EYFS/KS1 in planning/creating more outdoor learning opportunities, purchase resources/equipment to enable more focused Outdoor Learning to take place weekly in Reception and introduce Termly in Year 1 & 2.
Costing – courses/supply cover (Sports premium/ supply cover budget)
- Will enable pupils to participate in district and county competitions and tournaments as new skills are taught and improved through membership of SDSSP.
Costing – incorporated above
- Enable the school to purchase Cyber-Coach, an IWB dance programme to improve the teaching of dance across school.
Costing - £300.00
- Raise the profile of health and fitness of pupils through: participating in British Heart foundation skipping activities and KS2 to monitor their daily physical activity in a daily afternoon brisk walk (using pedometers) to inspire and encourage all pupils to partake in fun, physical activities that are rewarding and improve personal achievement and encourage healthy competition.
